

## **The Irish Prime Minister said that Britain will propose a new wording on the iss**

Irish Prime Minister Vlad Ekar said on Wednesday that British Prime Minister Theresa May told him that she would give advice to Anglo-Chinese negotiators within the next 24 hours in an attempt to break the border with Ireland. deadlock.

If Britain and Estonia negotiate their negotiations to advance to the next stage, interim agreements on this frontier issue are indispensable. Ireland agreed with a temporary border agreement on Monday after all parties to the negotiations pledged to implement "regulatory alignment" on both sides of the border between Ireland and the Northern Ireland Province.

However, the DUP denounced the regulatory differences between Northern Ireland and the rest of the UK. In a week's time, EU leaders will have a meeting to discuss whether to start trade negotiations with the United Kingdom, but the situation is complicated.

After a phone call with Theresa May earlier on Wednesday, Valadekar said at a news conference: "We talked about this idea. Of course, we did not discuss any specific words or words and phrases, but I Affirmatively indicate that I am willing to consider any British proposal. "
